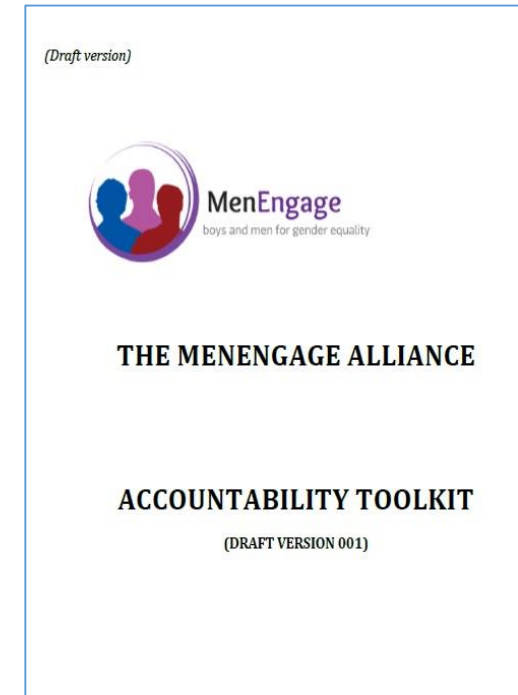

Accountability Standards



All members of MenEngage Alliance must sign the Code of Conduct.

Implementation experiences, positives and remaining challenges

- Masculinity Network for Gender Equality (RedMas) in Nicaragua: skepticism from women's movement; tools created space for uncomfortable conversations
- Code of conduct prevented membership by organizations that reinforce machismo (Latin America)
- Accountability steps led to joint funding proposals between MenEngage Africa and women's rights groups (Africa)
- Sexist behaviours or limited gender-transformational approaches within our network (Latin America, Africa)
